- To protect the research investigators involved in research at the University and its affiliated institutions by providing guidance;
- To protect the University and its affiliated institutions by providing guidance to the signatory institutions named herein and following the federal, state and local standards for human subject protections;
- To protect the volunteer members of the IRBs involved in the review of human research studies.
